II Policy:

Specifically trained Department of Corrections (DOC) personnel may be used to assist other law enforcement agencies in emergency situations.

III Definitions:

Specifically Trained Personnel:

For purposes of this policy, specifically trained personnel will normally include, but is not limited to, negotiators, critical incident debriefing team members and other personnel not directly involved in any use of force.

IV Procedures:

Request for Mutual Assistance:

- A. All requests received by the DOC from other law enforcement agencies for mutual assistance will be forwarded to the Secretary of Corrections.

Authorization of Mutual Assistance:

- A. Only the Secretary of Corrections, or in his/her absence the Deputy Secretary, may authorize mutual assistance to another law enforcement agency.
