


## Door Hangers

If a part of your work or volunteering involves making trips to people's homes, you know that a lot of times, no one is home. A clever idea to let them know that you were there, is a door hanger. A door hanger is generally 4.25" x 11" with a handy cut-out hook on thick paper stock that allows it to be left hanging from the doorknob.

We offer both, one and two-sided versions with one-color or full-color printing. It can have your logo on it and a message, such as the reason for your visit, along with your contact information. These are relatively inexpensive, only \$.09 each for an order of 1000. Give Chad a call at the Print Shop and he can help design one that will work for you.



### Window Clings

Schools and nonprofit organizations are frequently involved in fundraising efforts to augment their budgets. We have all had little folks at the door selling stuff we really don't want, even though we would like to help them out. Worst of all, most of the money collected goes to the product supply company, not to your local organization.

Instead of selling things, how about requesting donations for your group in exchange for a small window cling with your logo to display in the window of their car, business or home? A single-color cling with your message ("Boy Scout Supporter" "Cardinal Booster" "We Support High School Marching Band") is only \$.05 cents per square inch. For additional colors, add \$.01 per color. So, a clear, 3" x 9" cling with a one-color logo or print is only \$1.35 each. Grandparents are always good for at least a \$5.00 contribution. You do the math and keep the lion's share of funds raised with your local group instead of with the supplier.
