Rapid City Minimum Unit Garden Produces Three Tons of Food

Rapid City, S.D.- A new project at the Rapid City Minimum Unit is helping feed the hungry in that community.

Inmates at the minimum-security facility started a garden this year. All of the materials for the garden were donated by various community organizations who utilize inmate labor, including tilling by the Central States Fairgrounds, seeds provided by the Community Action Program office and yard waste compost from the Rapid City Landfill.

The produce harvested was given to the Rapid City Food Pantry at the Community Action Program to be dispersed throughout the area.
