

2nd Chance Act Grant National Evaluation

- All programs receiving Year 2 funding (7 of 15 of the original grantees) were selected to participate in the national evaluation.
- The South Dakota evaluation study will include 200 offenders randomly assigned to either a treatment or control group.

Potential Participant Selection

- Must meet 30/30 or 30/23 risk criteria.
- Must be releasing to parole in either Rapid City or Sioux Falls.
- In order to accommodate programming in the institution offenders being asked to participate must have a parole date 4-6 months in the future to give them time to complete any required programs.
- Must sign agreement to participate form, fill out baseline information sheet, and contact information sheet.

2nd Chance Act Grant National Evaluation

- February 1st 2012 the first potential evaluation participants were signed up as participants in the evaluation.
- As of 4/20/2012
 - ❖ 40 offenders have agreed to participate in the study.
 - ❖ 24 in TX group
 - ❖ 16 in Control group
 - ❖ 4 offenders have chosen to opt out of the study.
 - ❖ Offenders that opt out are not eligible for SCA funds for 1 year.

Control Group

- Offenders randomized into the control group will receive standard case management services in the institution.
- Control group participants are provided information about alternative programs available to them.
