These polypropylene tethers were developed for hands-on transports. Handcuffs can be slipped through the D-ring to provide the needed control while keeping a safety distance from detainee. \$3.00

Security mattresses are made from a poly-cotton canvas. They are designed to be used in situations where there is concern of self harm. While nothing can be completely tear resistant, this heavy canvas, with quilted squares, and with four rows of stitching on the perimeter, can drastically reduce the chances of it being used for self harm.

Mattresses with clear safe pvc covers not only stand up to heavy use but are also clear to reduce the likelihood of hiding contraband. Both four inch and six inch thickness are available.
