Search for missing Inmate

Sioux Falls, S.D.- Department of Corrections staff members and local law enforcement are searching for a missing state prison inmate from Sioux Falls.

Inmate Skyler Culp walked away from Unit C, the minimum-security unit of the Jameson Annex to the South Dakota State Penitentiary, this evening.

Culp is a 20-year-old white male with brown hair and blue eyes. He is 6-feet-1 inches tall and weighs approximately 218 pounds.

Culp was convicted of grand theft in Yankton County. He is currently serving two concurrent 10-year sentences with 8-years suspended on each sentence.

Anyone who sees Culp or knows of his whereabouts should contact law enforcement immediately.

There are nearly 800 minimum-security inmates housed across the state, including 247 at Unit C in Sioux Falls.
