Minimum-security inmate Lyle Iron Horn walked away from his community service job in Lemmon, SD on April 21, 2016. Iron Horn is housed at the Rapid City Community Work Center, but was working in Lemmon for his community service employer at the time he walked away.

Iron Horn, age 35, is a Native American male with black hair and brown eyes. He is 5-feet-6 and weighs approximately 210 pounds. He is currently serving time out of Pennington County for vehicular battery, third degree simple assault and eluding a police officer.
